



## Central Wyoming College GEAR UP Wyoming Institutional Scholarship Student Check List

The Central Wyoming College Institutional GEAR UP Wyoming (GUWY) Scholarship is a 2 year award if you meet scholarship continuation requirements

If funding is available, the scholarship <u>may</u> be held for the student for up to 2 years after graduation. Student must complete all of the application and award letter processes by <u>July 1 of senior year</u>

> There are 3 levels of awards based on either your GPA or ACT score

0	Gold:	GPA 3.5 or ACT of 25	\$4200/year
0	Silver:	GPA 3.0 or ACT 21	\$2970/year
0	Bronze:	GPA 2.75 (no ACT level)	\$500/year

- Verification of your participation in the GUWY Program from your "host" college site is required to receive this award. Participation is determined by:
  - Completed Senior Check List
  - Meaningful participant in the GUWY Program

## How to apply:

- □ Mail CWC <u>GEAR UP Wyoming Scholarship Application</u> (paper only) <u>to CWC GEAR UP</u> <u>Wyoming Project Manager, Tami Shultz</u>, by May 1 of senior year (priority date)
- □ Send <u>official</u> 7 semester high school transcript <u>to CWC</u> by May 1 of senior year (final transcript required after graduation)
- □ Verify GUWY Participation by May 1
- □ Sign and return Letter of Intent <u>to CWC GEAR UP Wyoming Project Manager, Tami Shultz</u>, by May 31 of senior year
- □ Complete all CWC Admissions requirements
  - Complete CWC application for attendance by May 1 of senior year
  - Provide CWC with final "official" transcript showing graduation date and final cumulative GPA by July 1
  - Enroll at CWC for a minimum of 12 credit hours

## **Requirements for Continuation of Award:**

- 1. <u>GPA</u> Renewal Requirements:
  - Gold: Maintain minimum of 3.0 GPA each semester
  - Silver: Maintain minimum of 2.5 GPA each semester
  - Bronze: Maintain minimum of 2.5 GPA each semester
- 2. Enroll and Successfully Complete a minimum of <u>12 credit hours</u>
- 3. Initial interview with CWC GUWY Project Manager
- 4. Attend the freshmen <u>CWC GEAR UP Wyoming Welcome Event</u>
- 5. Apply to the CWC TRIO Program and adhere to TRIO requirements
- 6. Attendance to CWC <u>GEAR UP</u> meetings/activities
- 7. Monthly meetings with CWC GUWY College Success Coach or Site Manager
- 8. Monthly meetings with CWC GUWY Mentor during first year of college
